

Chief Executive Officer, HKKP Visited Progressive Farmers' Fields in Panchkula District

Panchkula, 27 August 2026

Dr. R. S. Chauhan, Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Haryana Kisan Kalyan Pradhikaran (HKKP), visited the fields and farming enterprises of progressive farmers in District Panchkula on 27 August 2026. The visits were aimed at understanding the farmers' experiences, innovative agricultural practices, challenges and opportunities in diversified farming.



During the first visit, Dr. Chauhan visited the farm of Sh. Vikram Singh at Village Manak Tabra, District Panchkula.

Sh. Vikram Singh is engaged in diversified farming on approximately 20 acres of land, including agriculture, vegetable cultivation, agro-forestry and dairy farming. The CEO interacted with the farmer and observed the various farming activities being undertaken on the farm. Discussions were held regarding crop diversification, vegetable production, dairy farming and the challenges faced by farmers in ensuring better productivity and marketing of their produce. Sh. Vikram Singh had requested Dr. Chauhan to inspect his eucalyptus plants regarding incidence of some disease. After field inspection the farmer was suggested to apply balanced fertilizer and some fungicides.

In the second visit, Dr. Chauhan visited the farm of Sh. Mohit Sharma at Village Rehore, District Panchkula, who is engaged in agriculture and vegetable cultivation on approximately 5 acres of land. The CEO inspected the crops and found that his paddy crop is infected with leaf folder and stem borer. There was serious infection of BCB disease. After inspection of the field, suitable management practices recommended by the university were suggested. The discussion also focused on the potential for adopting improved technologies and diversification to enhance farm income.



During the visits, Dr. Chauhan appreciated the efforts of both farmers towards adopting diversified farming practices. He emphasized the importance of promoting sustainable and diversified agriculture, adoption of improved technologies, value addition and better market linkages. The interactions with farmers provide valuable insights into the practical challenges faced by the farming community and help the Haryana Kisan Kalyan Pradhikaran in formulating farmer-centric recommendations and interventions.
