

Consultation/Interaction meeting with Agriculture Experts regarding Working Groups to be constituted by Haryana Kisan Kalyan Pradhikara

Haryana Kisan Kalyan Pradhikaran organized a meeting on 17.03.2025 at CCS Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar with the esteemed representatives of CCS Hayana Agricultural University, Hisar, Maharana Pratap Horticultural University, Uchani, Karnal and Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Hisar to discuss the selection of agriculture experts who will contribute to the writing of a comprehensive working group report on various agricultural issues. The meeting, organized by the Pradhikaran, brought together from multiple institutions to streamline the process of identifying subject matter experts in critical areas of agriculture.



The meeting was chaired by Dr. R. S. Chauhan, Chief Executive Officer, HKKP in which, Directors of research, extension, human resource and other eminent experts of agriculture universities in the state participated. Dr. Chauhan emphasized the need for collaborative efforts between academic institutions and government bodies to address the pressing agricultural challenges in the state. Attendees were tasked with recommending names of qualified agriculture experts who could contribute their knowledge to the working group, which will focus on a wide range of topics such as agro forestry, floriculture, goat and sheep farming, seed production for cereal and forage crops and kharif oil seeds and pulses.



As part of the meeting, university representatives shared insights into the latest research and innovations in agriculture, which could potentially influence the direction of the working group's report. The session also provided an opportunity for participants to discuss how academic research can be better translated into real-world applications to benefit farmers on the ground.

The agriculture experts nominated by the universities will soon be invited to contribute their expertise to the working group. Their recommendations will be compiled into a detailed report, which will serve as a guideline for future agricultural practices and policy frameworks.
