

Research Fellow Visits Progressive Mushroom Farm at Morni; HKKP Extends Support for Expansion Initiative

As part of its continued efforts to promote innovative agricultural practices and agri-entrepreneurship in Haryana, Ms. Vandana, Research Fellow, Haryana Kisan Kalyan Pradhikaran (HKKP), visited the mushroom cultivation unit of progressive farmer Sh. Virender Bajwan at Village Badiyal, Morni.

During the visit, Ms. Vandana interacted with Sh. Bajwan and his family to understand the functioning of the farm, the cultivation techniques adopted for high-value medicinal mushrooms such as Ganoderma, Shiitake and Cordyceps, and the value-addition processes being undertaken. She also reviewed the entrepreneur's efforts in promoting mushroom cultivation, farmer training, and rural entrepreneurship, which have made the farm a model of agricultural innovation in the state.

The visit also included detailed discussions regarding Sh. Bajwan's vision of establishing a Mushroom Cultivation, Organic Farming and Modern Agriculture Training Centre to provide practical training and entrepreneurship opportunities for farmers, students and rural youth. Haryana Kisan Kalyan Pradhikaran has recommended the establishment of this proposed training centre in the partially constructed Panchayat building at Village Subana, District Jhajjar, subject to the applicable approvals and procedures. The proposed centre is expected to become a hub for skill development, modern agricultural technologies, value addition and self-employment in southern Haryana.

The visit reaffirmed HKKP's commitment to identifying and supporting progressive farmers whose innovative initiatives can serve as replicable models for agricultural diversification, sustainable farming and enhanced farmer incomes across Haryana.
